Christmas Woodworking Projects



Philip Woodland has been busy making cutting boards for Christmas presents. He uses walnut, maple and cherry woods in a

variety of patterns.



J. Goodwin built his mother-in-law a wine cabinet using black walnut and alder stained with Minwax black walnut stain. It

measures 14" wide, 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' deep and 34 $\frac{1}{4}$ ' tall. He applied two coats of blond shellac and then a Minwax Wipe-on Poly finish.

He also built his mother a 'waterfall' cutting



board. Waterfall means that it is built with two pieces that go over the edge and down the side of the countertop.

And he also built her an end table using



cherry. It measures $15\frac{1}{2}$ " wide, 23" deep and 22" high. It has a unique 'pull out' writing desk she can use when she's using her 'iPad'.

J used a coat of blond shellac to enhance the grain and followed it with three coats of Minwax Wipe-on Poly finish.

J plans to make her a matching end table in February that has a storage drawer instead of the writing desk.
