Show & Tells

Our January program was show & tell about various jigs our members use to make their woodworking safer, faster and more precise.



Dean Partridge designed a jig to help him precisely drill the slats on plantation shutters



Earl Rutherford brought several items he recently turned; a large walnut vase, a large pecan bowl and 2 goblets, one oak and one willow.



Richard Hicks brought a dial indicator holder used to set knives on a jointer or planer. He also brought a jig he uses to determine the wall thickness while turning hollow vessels.



Howard Hartman brought his table saw miter sled and a cabinet door he assembled with his Kreg Jig.



Lyman Frugia brought a jig he designed to turn some custom profile rosettes on his lathe.



John Phelps brought several jigs. This is a hand router plane. It has a very fine adjustment to insure a perfect fit.



This is a jig he uses to cut LARGE SIZE dovetails in things like cabinets and chests. And this is a special jig used to cut tenons on his router table.



John is a master jig designer and maker. They really add a lot of safety and precision to his woodworking.

B.J. Holt brought a adapter that allows you to use a Delta "Unifence" blade on a Delta Biesemeyer Fence. He also brought a
